Kindergarten	Civil Engineers	Build a bridge that can hold 200 pennies!
1 st Grade	Architectural Engineers	Design & build an igloo that is at least 4"x4"
2 nd Grade	Mechanical Engineers	Design an object that can be pushed or pulled on a course using magnets
3 rd Grade	Structural Engineers	Design a Sprout House
4 th & 5 th Grade	Structural Engineers	Design & build a basketball tower
