Digital Citizenship: Staying "TechSafe"

The Palm Beach County TechSafe Initiative is designed to provide an age-appropriate instructional program for all students regarding technology and internet safety, cyberbullying awareness, and model digital citizenship. These lessons are taught in the months of November and December in the Technology Lab.

The titles of the grade level Common Sense Media "TechSafe" lessons are as follows:

Kindergarten - "Going Places Safely" - Students learn they can go to exciting places online, but they need to follow certain rules to remain safe.

First Grade - "Sending Email" - Students explore how they can use email to communicate with real people within schools, families, and communities.

Second Grade - "Show Respect Online" - Students explore the similarities and differences between in-person and online communication and then learn how to write clear and respectful online messages.

Third Grade - "Talking Safely Online" - Students learn that, while people can develop rewarding friendships online, they should be cautious with online-only friends and never reveal private information without asking a parent or trusted adult for permission.

Fourth Grade - "The Power of Words" - Students consider that while they are enjoying their favorite websites they may encounter messages from other kids that can make them feel angry, hurt, sad, or fearful. Students will explore ways to handle cyberbullying.

Fifth Grade - "Digital Citizenship Pledge" - Students establish group norms to create a positive online community that promotes responsible and respectful digital behavior within their classroom. Students collaborate in creating a digital citizenship pledge.
